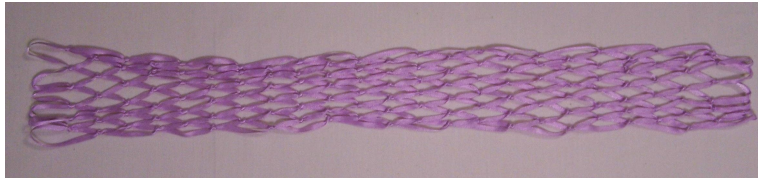


Beautiful and Practical Netting

Plain Headband (narrow)

The instructions in this pattern do *not* include directions on how to tie the basic netting knot or any other basic netting skills.

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Tools

netting needle or shuttle
scissors
tension device
tape measure

Supplies

10 yards of ribbon or crochet thread
12 inches elastic cord

Mesh Sticks

$\frac{3}{4}$ " flat mesh stick
1" flat mesh stick

144 knots for this headband

Instructions for the headband

Rows	Mesh Stick	Instructions
1	$\frac{3}{4}$ " flat	Net 6 loops into foundation loop.
2- 23	$\frac{3}{4}$ " flat	Net 1 knot in each loop.
24	1" flat	Net 1 knot in each loop.

Remove foundation loop.

To join into a circle:

1. Cut a 10" - 12" piece of elastic cord.
2. Pass the elastic cord through the loops formed in row 1 and then continue to pass the cord through the loops formed in row 24.
3. Make sure the headband is not twisted.
4. Tie the elastic cord into a circle with an overhand knot.
