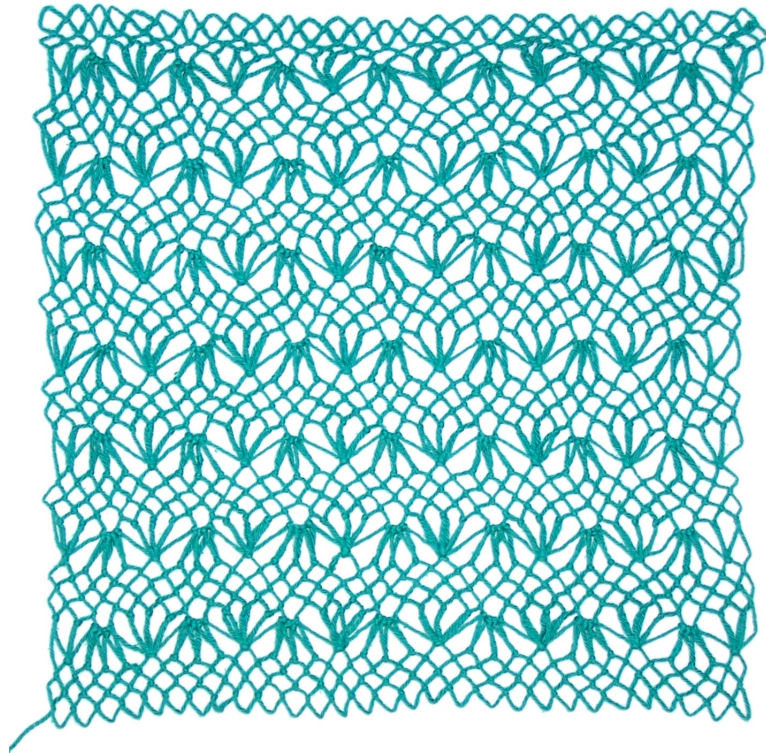


Beautiful and Practical Netting

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Fan Dishcloth

Tools	Supplies	Mesh Sticks	Total Knots in dishcloth
netting needle or shuttle scissors tension device tape measure	64 yards size 4 cotton yarn (Example: Lily's "Sugar and Cream")	$\frac{3}{8}$ " flat 1" flat	1,249

Dishcloth Instructions

Row	Mesh Stick	Instructions	Knots in Row
1-3	$\frac{3}{8}$ "	Create a net chain 58 knots long. Place the last loop made onto the foundation-loop cord. Place all the other loops on that side of the chain onto the foundation-loop cord. Tie the foundation-loop cord into a circle - 58 loops in the chain, 29 loops in each row.	58
4	$\frac{3}{8}$ "	Net 1 knot in each loop.	29
5	1"	Net 1 knot in each loop for 2 loops, net 4 knots in the next loop, *net 1 knot in each loop for 3 loops, net 4 knots in the next loop*; repeat from * to *, ending with net 1 knot in each loop for 2 loops.	50
6	$\frac{3}{8}$ "	Net 2 loops together, net 1 knot in each loop for 3 loops, *net 4 loops together, net 1 knot in each loop for 3 loops; * repeat from * to *, ending with net 3 loops together.	29

Row	Mesh Stick	Instructions	Knots in Row
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7-9	3/8"	Net 1 knot in each loop.	29
10	1"	repeat row 5	50
11	3/8"	repeat row 6	29
12-14	3/8"	Net 1 knot in each loop.	29
15	1"	repeat row 5	50
16	3/8"	repeat row 6	29
17-19	3/8"	Net 1 knot in each loop.	29
20	1"	repeat row 5	50
21	3/8"	repeat row 6	29
22-24	3/8"	Net 1 knot in each loop.	29
25	1"	repeat row 5	50
26	3/8"	repeat row 6	29
27-29	3/8"	Net 1 knot in each loop.	29
30	1"	repeat row 5	50
31	3/8"	repeat row 6	29
32-34	3/8"	Net 1 knot in each loop.	29
35	1"	repeat row 5	50
36	3/8"	repeat row 6	29
37-39	3/8"	Net 1 knot in each loop.	29

Cut the yarn from the shuttle. Weave the ends on the first and last rows back into the netting .
