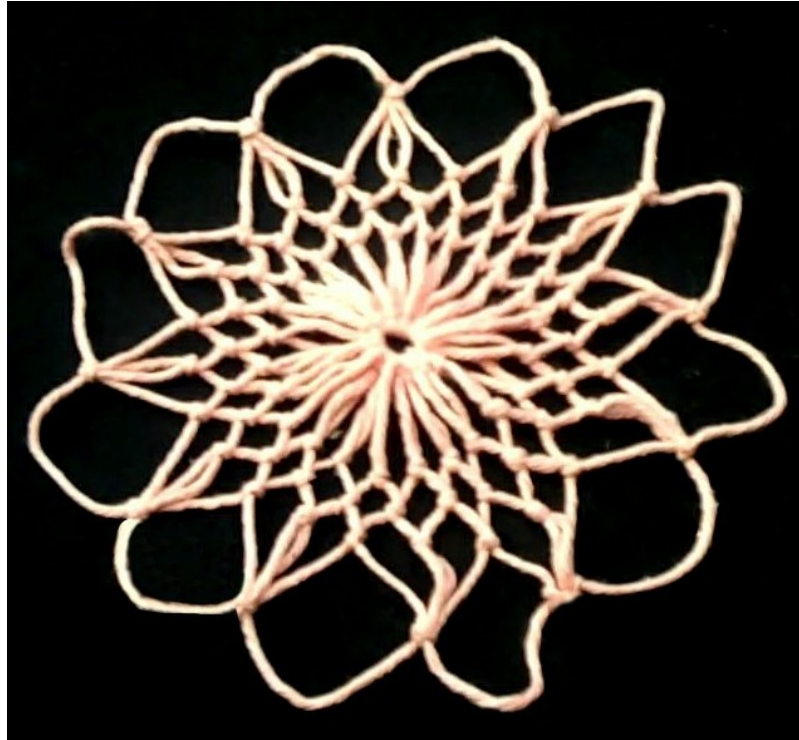


Ending the Last Round



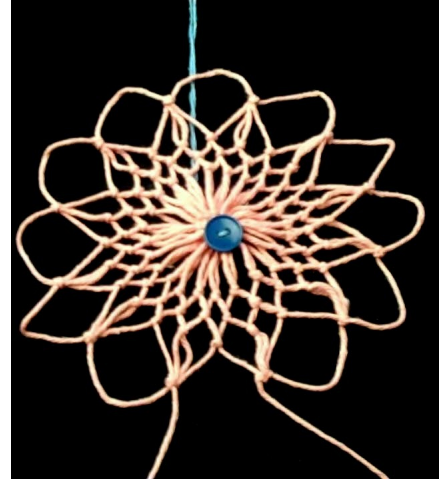

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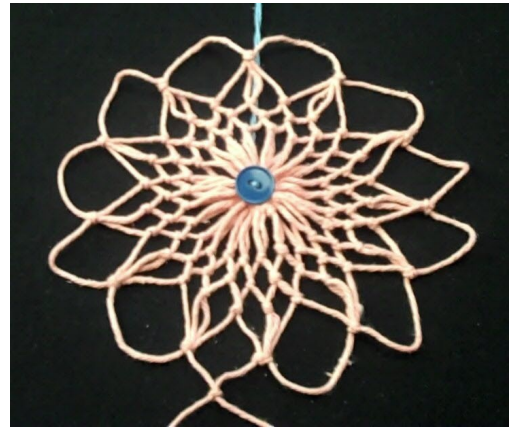
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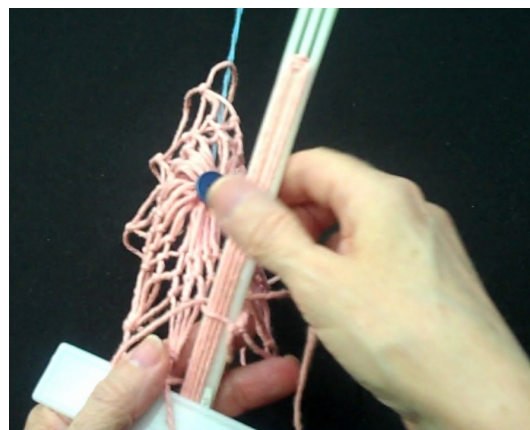
At the end of the final round of your project,



do NOT tie a CK where you normally would.



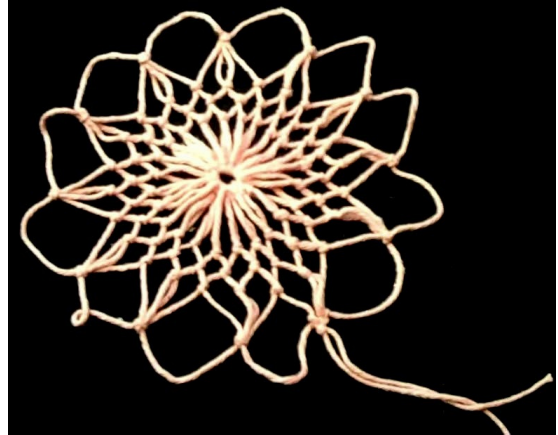
Instead, net 1 more knot into the loop at the beginning of the round (the loop formed by the CK).



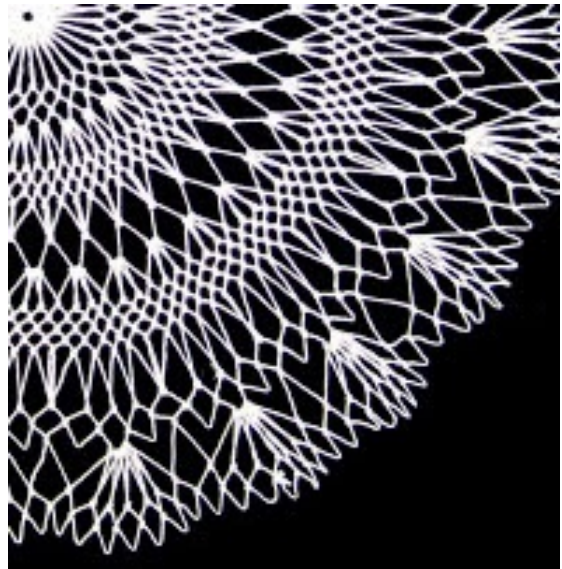
Then tie the CK, making sure that it is firmly against the knot just net.

There is no new loop formed by tying the CK in this manner. The CK is tied on one of the sides of a mesh rather than in the center of a loop. This makes all the loops in the last round look the same.

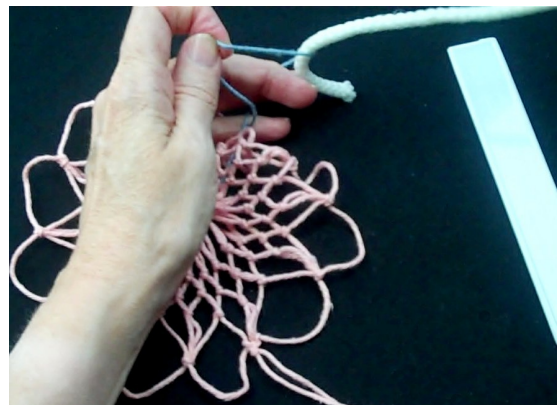
If the netting is made with yarn, cut both ends leaving a 4" tail. Then weave the ends into the netting.



If the netting is made with crochet thread, cut both threads leaving each thread as a small 1/8" long tail.



Remove the anchor from the tension device.



Remove the anchor from the netting.



Look at your piece of netting and enjoy it.
