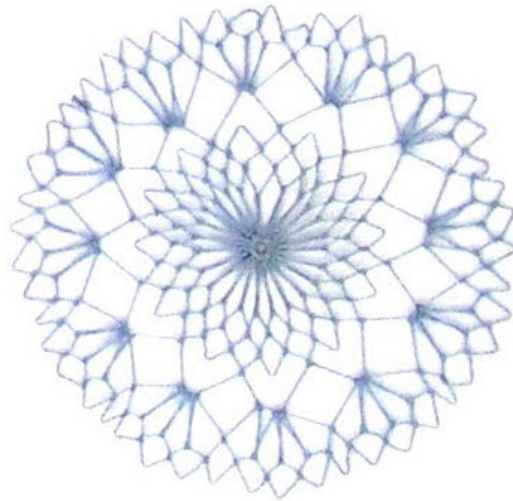

Supplies needed:

cord to put through anchor
grommet anchor made of bead and crochet thread
netting needle or shuttle
scissors

Bookmark

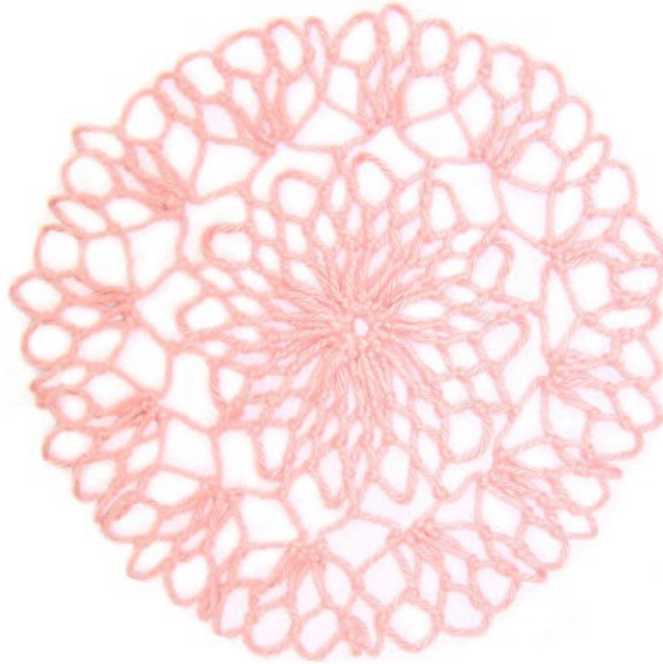
mesh sticks:
1/4" flat mesh stick
#1 knitting needle (kn)
#3 knitting needle (kn)
tatting or size 30 crochet thread: 9 yards

Coaster Insert

mesh sticks:
1/4" flat mesh stick
#1 knitting needle (kn)
tatting or size 30 crochet thread: 4 yards

Hot Pad

mesh sticks:
1" flat mesh sticks
3/4" flat mesh sticks
3/8" flat mesh sticks
medium weight household string or size 4 cotton yarn: 13 yards

252 knots for this hot pad

Instructions

Regular (center)

Round 1

mesh stick: 1"

Form a grommet with 24 loops, last one tied by hand with a CK. (24 loops in round)

Rounds 2-4

mesh stick: 3/8"

Net 1 knot in each loop, last one tied by hand with a CK. (24 loops in round)

Mirror (increase)

Round 5

mesh stick: 3/4"

Skip a loop, net 1 knot in the next loop. Last loop tied by hand with a CK. (12 loops in round)

Round 6

mesh stick: 3/4"

Net 3 more knots in the loop formed by the CK, net 4 knots in all other loops. Last loop tied by hand with a CK. (48 loops in round)

Rounds 7-8

mesh stick: 3/8"

Net 1 knot in each loop. Last loop tied by hand with a CK. (48 loops in round)



Floweret: A Coaster Insert

252 knots for this coaster insert

Instructions

Regular (center)

Round 1

mesh stick: 1/4"

Form a grommet with 24 loops, last one tied by hand with a CK. (24 loops in round)

Rounds 2-4

mesh stick: #1 kn

Net 1 knot in each loop, last one tied by hand with a CK. (24 loops in round)

Mirror (increase)

Round 5

mesh stick: 1/4"

Skip a loop, net 1 knot in the next loop. Last loop tied by hand with a CK. (12 loops in round)

Round 6

mesh stick: 1/4"

Net 3 more knots in the loop formed by the CK, net 4 knots in all other loops. Last loop tied by hand with a CK. (48 loops in round)

Rounds 7-8

mesh stick: #1 kn

Net 1 knot in each loop. Last loop tied by hand with a CK. (48 loops in round)

Floweret: A Net Bookmark

Total Knots: 576

Instructions

Circular Topper

2.75" diameter

252 knots for this bookmark topper

Regular (center)

Round 1

mesh stick: 1/4"

Form a grommet with 24 loops, last one tied by hand with a CK. (24 loops in round)

Rounds 2-4

mesh stick: #1 kn

Net 1 knot in each loop, last one tied by hand with a CK. (24 loops in round)

Mirror (increase stitch)

Round 5

mesh stick: 1/4"

Skip a loop, net 1 knot in the next loop, last loop tied by hand with a CK. (12 loops in round)

Round 6

mesh stick: 1/4"

Net 3 more knots in the loop formed by the CK, net 4 knots in all other loops, last loop tied by hand with a CK. (48 loops in round)

Rounds 7-8

mesh stick: #1 kn

Net 1 knot in each loop, last loop tied by hand with a CK. (48 loops in round)

Bookmark Length

324 knots in this bookmark length

Row 1

mesh stick: #3 kn

Attach the thread from the netting needle to a loop or use the CK. Then place the attached knot or CK on top of the mesh stick and net 1 knot in each loop for 9 loops. (10 knots on the mesh stick.)

Rows 2-36

mesh stick: #3 kn

Turn netting, net 1 knot in each loop for 9 loops. (9 loops in row)
