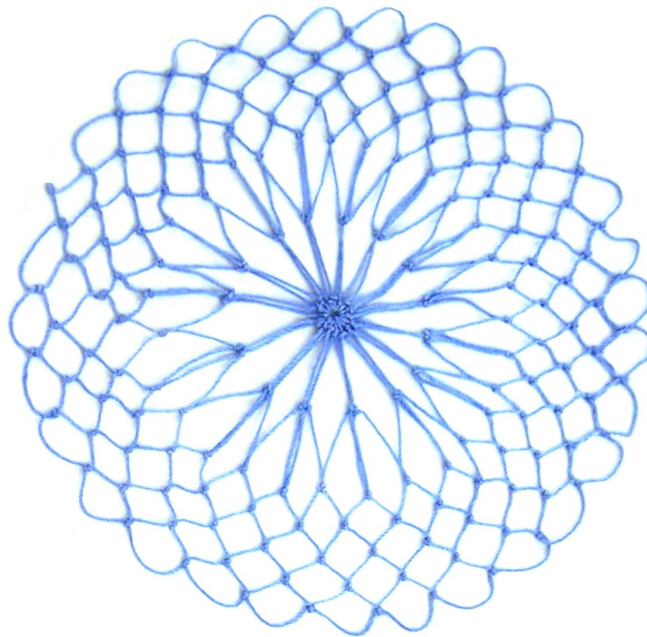


# *Beautiful and Practical Netting*

## **Supplies needed:**

cord to put through anchor  
grommet anchor made of bead and crochet thread  
netting needle or shuttle  
scissors

## **Bookmark**

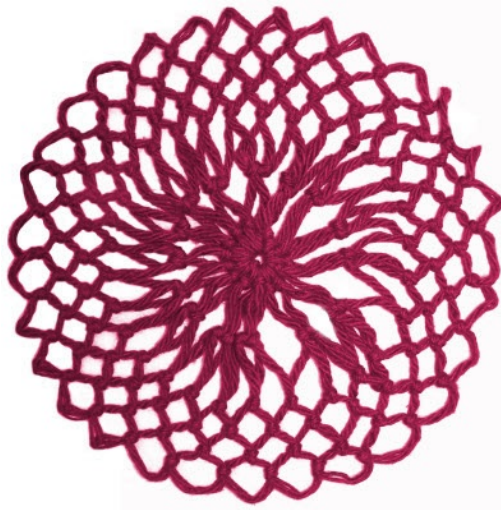
mesh sticks:  
3/8" flat mesh sticks  
#3 knitting needle (kn)  
tatting or size 30 crochet thread: 20 yards

## **Coaster Insert**

mesh sticks:  
1/4" flat mesh sticks  
#2 knitting needle (kn)  
tatting or size 30 crochet thread: 5 yards

## **Hot Pad**

mesh sticks:  
1/2" flat mesh sticks  
3/8" knitting needle (kn)  
medium weight household string or size 4 cotton yarn: 9 yards

## **Instructions**

### **Well (center)**

#### **Round 1**

mesh stick: 1"

Form a grommet with 15 loops, last one tied by hand with a CK. (15 loops in round)

#### **Round 2**

mesh stick: 3/4"

Net 1 knot in loop formed by CK, net 2 knots in all other loops. Last loop tied by hand with a CK. (30 loops in round)

#### **Rounds 3-6**

mesh stick: 3/8"

Net 1 knot in each loop. Last loop tied by hand with a CK. (30 loops in round)

**Well (center)**

**Round 1**

mesh stick: 3/8"

Form a grommet with 15 loops, last one tied by hand with a CK. (15 loops in round)

**Round 2**

mesh stick: 3/8"

Net 1 knot in loop formed by CK, net 2 knots in all other loops. Last loop tied by hand with a CK. (30 loops in round)

**Rounds 3-7**

mesh stick: #2 kn

Net 1 knot in each loop. Last loop tied by hand with a CK. (30 loops in round)

**Well: A Bookmark**

Total Knots: 380

**Instructions**

**Circular Topper**

3" diameter

165 knots in this bookmark topper

**Well (center)**

**Round 1**

mesh stick: 3/8"

Form a grommet with 15 loops,  
last one tied by hand with a CK.  
(15 loops in round)

**Round 2**

mesh stick: 3/8"

Net 1 knot in loop formed by CK,  
net 2 knots in all other loops.  
Last loop tied by hand with a CK.  
(30 loops in round)

**Rounds 3-6**

mesh stick: #3 kn

Net 1 knot in each loop. Last  
loop tied by hand with a CK. (30  
loops in round)

**Shield Stitch Bookmark Length**

225 knots in this bookmark length

**Row 1**

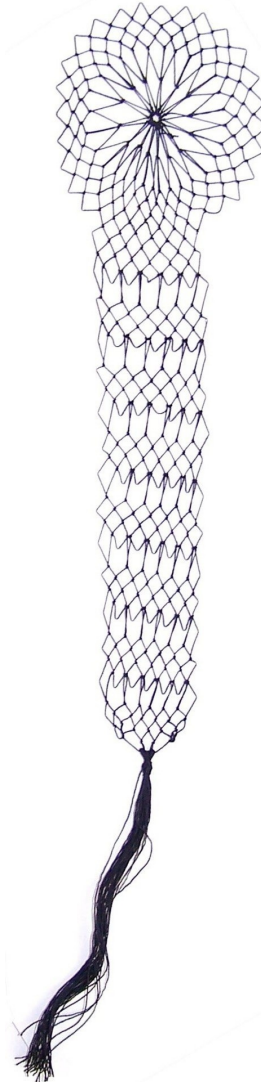
mesh stick: #3 kn

Attach the thread to a loop, net 1 knot in each loop for 6 loops. (7 knots on the mesh stick.)

**Rows 2-3**

mesh stick: #3 kn

Turn netting, net 1 knot in each loop for 6 loops. (6 loops in row)



**Row 4**

mesh stick: #3 kn

Wrap thread twice around mesh stick before making knot, net 1 knot in first loop (this creates a long loop). \*Net 1 knot in next loop (this creates a short loop), wrap thread twice around mesh stick before making knot and net 1 more knot in same loop (this creates a long loop)\*; repeat from \* to \* across row. (11 loops in row)

**Rows 5-7**

mesh stick: #3 kn

Net 1 knot in each long loop. (6 loops in row)

**Row 8**

mesh stick: #3 kn

Wrap thread twice around mesh stick before making knot, net 1 knot in first loop (this creates a long loop). \*Net 1 knot in next loop (this creates a short loop), wrap thread twice around mesh stick before making knot and net 1 more knot in same loop (this creates a long loop)\*; repeat from \* to \* across row. (11 loops in row)

**Rows 9-11**

mesh stick: #3 kn

Net 1 knot in each long loop. (6 loops in row)

**Row 12**

mesh stick: #3 kn

Wrap thread twice around mesh stick before making knot, net 1 knot in first loop (this creates a long loop). \*Net 1 knot in next loop (this creates a short loop), wrap thread twice around mesh stick before making knot and net 1 more knot in same loop (this creates a long loop)\*; repeat from \* to \* across row. (11 loops in row)

**Rows 13-15**

mesh stick: #3 kn

Net 1 knot in each long loop. (6 loops in row)

**Row 16**

mesh stick: #3 kn

Wrap thread twice around mesh stick before making knot, net 1 knot in first loop (this creates a long loop). \*Net 1 knot in next loop (this creates a short loop), wrap thread twice around mesh stick before making knot and net 1 more knot in same loop (this creates a long loop)\*; repeat from \* to \* across row. (11 loops in row)

**Rows 17-19**

mesh stick: #3 kn

Net 1 knot in each long loop. (6 loops in row)



**Row 20**

mesh stick: #3 kn

Wrap thread twice around mesh stick before making knot, net 1 knot in first loop (this creates a long loop). \*Net 1 knot in next loop (this creates a short loop), wrap thread twice around mesh stick before making knot and net 1 more knot in same loop (this creates a long loop)\*; repeat from \* to \* across row. (11 loops in row)

**Rows 21-23**

mesh stick: #3 kn

Net 1 knot in each long loop. (6 loops in row)

**Row 24**

mesh stick: #3 kn

Wrap thread twice around mesh stick before making knot, net 1 knot in first loop (this creates a long loop). \*Net 1 knot in next loop (this creates a short loop), wrap thread twice around mesh stick before making knot and net 1 more knot in same loop (this creates a long loop)\*; repeat from \* to \* across row. (11 loops in row)

**Rows 25-27**

mesh stick: #3 kn

Net 1 knot in each long loop. (6 loops in row)

**Row 28**

mesh stick: #3 kn

Wrap thread twice around mesh stick before making knot, net 1 knot in first loop (this creates a long loop). \*Net 1 knot in next loop (this creates a short loop), wrap thread twice around mesh stick before making knot and net 1 more knot in same loop (this creates a long loop)\*; repeat from \* to \* across row. (11 loops in row)

**Row 29-31**

mesh stick: #3 kn

Net 1 knot in each long loop. (6 loops in row)

**Row 32**

mesh stick: #3 kn

Without mesh stick, net 2 loops together. Now with mesh stick, net 1 knot in each loop to, but not including last 2 loops. Net last 2 loops together. (3 loops in row)

Cut thread from needle leaving a length about 5 inches long on the bookmark.

## **Making the Tassel**

1. Cut 42 pieces of thread about 10 inches long.
2. Put 14 pieces into each loop on the last row.
3. Adjust the pieces so that the ends are even.
4. Wrap a 12" length of thread around the strands several times, about 1/2" from the end of the netting.
5. Tie the ends of this thread together.
6. Trim tassel.
