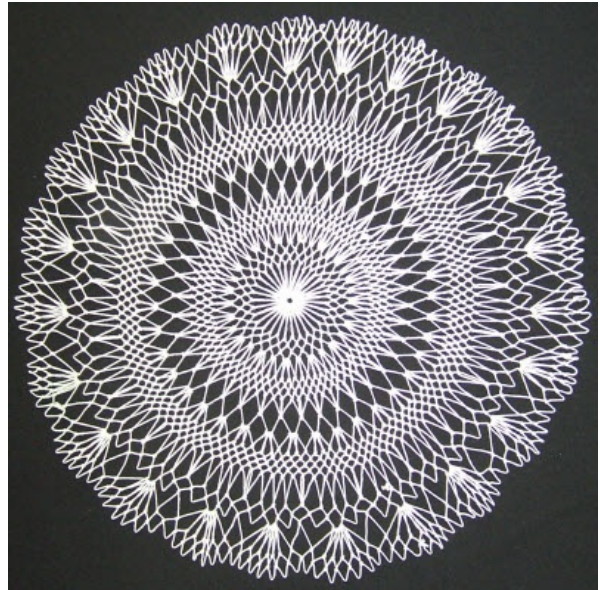


Beautiful and Practical Netting

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Supplies needed:

cord to put through anchor

size 10, 20, or 30 crochet thread: 43 yards

grommet anchor made of bead and crochet thread

mesh sticks:

5/8" flat mesh stick

3/8" flat mesh stick

1/4" flat mesh stick

#3 knitting needle

netting needle

scissors

1,984 knots in doily

This doily, like any other, can be made using any color combination desired. Originally my grandmother made this doily using scraps of threads. Her color pattern is as follows:

Rounds 1 through 8 - white
Rounds 9 through 11 - red
Rounds 12 through 15 - white
Rounds 16 through 19 - variegated yellow
Round 20 - red
Round 21 - light blue

Doily Instructions:

REGULAR (center)

Round 1

mesh stick: 5/8"

In foundation loop net 32 loops (last one tied by hand with CK). (32 knots in round)

Rounds 2-4

mesh stick: #3 kn

Net 1 knot in each loop. (32 knots in round)

CARROTS (increase stitch)

Round 5

mesh stick: 3/8"

Net 1 knot in loop formed by CK, *net 3 knots in next loop, net 2 knots in next loop*; repeat from * to * ending with net 3 knots in last loop. (80 knots in round)

Rounds 6-8

mesh stick: #3 kn

Net 1 knot in each loop. (80 knots in round)

BEET (increase stitch)

Round 9

mesh stick: 3/8"

Net 1 knot in each loop. (80 knots in round)

Round 10

mesh stick: 3/8"

Without mesh stick net loop formed by CK and loop to right of CK together, with mesh stick *net 2 loops together*; repeat from * to *. (40 knots in round)

Round 11

mesh stick: 3/8"

Net 2 knots in loop formed by CK, net 3 knots in all other loops. (120 knots in round)

Rounds 12-15

mesh stick: #3 kn

Net 1 knot in each loop. (120 knots in round)

CLOVER (decrease stitch)

Round 16

mesh stick: 5/8"

Net 1 knot in each loop. (120 knots in round)

Round 17

mesh stick: 1/4"

Net 1 knot in each loop for 2 loops, *net 2 loops together, net 1 knot in each loop for 3 loops*; repeat from * to *, ending with net 2 loops together. (96 knots in round)

Round 18

mesh stick: 1/4"

Net 1 knot in each loop. (96 knots in round)

FLOWER (edge)

Round 19

mesh stick: 5/8"

Skip a loop, net 6 knots in next loop, *skip a loop, net 1 knot in next loop, skip a loop, net 6 knots in next loop*; repeat from * to *. (168 knots in round)

Rounds 20-21

mesh stick: #7 kn

Net 1 knot in each loop. (168 knots in round)
