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## **Supplies needed:**

tension device

cord to put through anchor

grommet anchor made of bead and crochet thread

netting needle or shuttle

scissors

mesh sticks:

1" flat mesh stick

1/2" flat mesh stick

50 yards of size 4 cotton yarn or household string)

# Large Circular Net Bag with Net Handle

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894 knots for this bag

## Bag

### Round 1

mesh stick: 1"

Form grommet with 24 loops (last one tied by hand with CK). (24 loops in round)

### Rounds 2-18

mesh stick: 1"

Net 1 knot in each loop (last one tied by hand with CK). (24 loops in round)

## Handle Part 1:

### Row 1

mesh stick: 1"

Net 1 knot in each loop for 12 loops. Turn netting. (12 loops in row)

### Row 2

mesh stick: 1"

Net 1 knot in each loop until 2 loops are left, net the last 2 loops together. Turn the netting. (11 loops in row)

### Row 3

mesh stick: 1"

Net 1 knot in each loop until 2 loops are left, net the last 2 loops together. Turn the netting. (10 loops in row)

### Row 4

mesh stick: 1"

Net 1 knot in each loop until 2 loops are left, net the last 2 loops together. Turn the netting. (9 loops in row)

### Row 5

mesh stick: 1"

Net 1 knot in each loop until 2 loops are left, net the last 2 loops together. Turn the netting. (8 loops in row)

**Row 6**

mesh stick: 1"

Net 1 knot in each loop until 2 loops are left, net the last 2 loops together.  
Turn the netting. (7 loops in row)

**Row 7**

mesh stick: 1"

Net 1 knot in each loop until 2 loops are left, net the last 2 loops together.  
Turn the netting. (6 loops in row)

**Rows 8-35**

mesh stick: 1/2"

Net 1 knot in each loop. After last row, cut yarn leaving a 4-5 inch tail and  
weave it into previous netting. (6 loops in row)

**Handle Part 2:**

Tie the string from the netting shuttle onto the string on round 18 that was used to  
form the CK

**Row 1**

mesh stick: 1"

Net 1 knot in each loop for 12 loops. Turn netting. (12 loops in row)

**Row 2**

mesh stick: 1"

Net 1 knot in each loop until 2 loops are left, net the last 2 loops together.  
Turn the netting. (11 loops in row)

**Row 3**

mesh stick: 1"

Net 1 knot in each loop until 2 loops are left, net the last 2 loops together.  
Turn the netting. (10 loops in row)

**Row 4**

mesh stick: 1"

Net 1 knot in each loop until 2 loops are left, net the last 2 loops together.  
Turn the netting. (9 loops in row)

**Row 5**

mesh stick: 1"

Net 1 knot in each loop until 2 loops are left, net the last 2 loops together.  
Turn the netting. (8 loops in row)

**Row 6**

mesh stick: 1"

Net 1 knot in each loop until 2 loops are left, net the last 2 loops together.  
Turn the netting. (7 loops in row)

**Row 7**

mesh stick: 1"

Net 1 knot in each loop until 2 loops are left, net the last 2 loops together.  
Turn the netting. (6 loops in row)

**Rows 8-35**

mesh stick: 1/2"

Net 1 knot in each loop. After last row, cut yarn leaving a 4-5 inch tail and  
weave it into previous netting. (6 loops in row)

**Join Handle Part 1 and Handle Part 2:**

Tie handle parts one and two together to form single handle.
