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Supplies needed:

tension device such as a cord to put through anchor
grommet anchor made of bead and crochet thread
scissors

Yarn Snood

netting shuttle

mesh sticks:

1" flat mesh stick

1/2" flat mesh stick

worsted weight yarn: about 40 yards (about 5 yards of that is for the cord)

Thread Snood

netting needle

mesh sticks:

3/4" flat mesh stick

3/8" flat mesh stick

size 30 crochet thread: about 40 yards (about 5 yards of that is for the cord)

Instructions for Snood

Web (center)

Round 1

mesh stick: 1"

Form grommet with 12 loops (last one tied by hand with CK). (12 loops in round)

Round 2

mesh stick: 1"

Net 1 knot in each loop. (12 loops in round)

Round 3

mesh stick: 1"

Net 3 more knots in loop formed by CK, net 4 knots in all other loops. (48 loops in round)

Plain (decorative stitch)

Rounds 4-17

mesh stick: 1/2"

Net 1 knot in each loop. (48 loops in round)

To make cord:

1. Use about 5 yards of yarn.
2. Tie ends together to make circle.
3. Put ring through circle at knot end and fasten to something.
4. Put pencil into circle and twist.
5. Twist pencil to twist yarn.
6. When tightly twisted, remove pencil and ring (holding ends firmly).
7. Bring ends of twisted yarn together.
8. Tie ends with overhand knot to keep cord from untwisting.
9. Allow yarn to twist forming a thicker cord of yarn.
10. Run hand along length of cord to make the twist even.

Run cord through all loops around netting. Tie to fit head.

Instructions for Snood

Web (center)

Round 1

mesh stick: 3/4"

Form grommet with 12 loops (last one tied by hand with CK). (12 loops in round)

Round 2

mesh stick: 3/4"

Net 1 knot in each loop. (12 loops in round)

Round 3

mesh stick: 3/4"

Net 3 more knots in loop formed by CK, net 4 knots in all other loops. (48 loops in round)

Plain (decorative stitch)

Rounds 4-19

mesh stick: 3/8"

Net 1 knot in each loop. (48loops in round)

To make cord:

1. Use about 5 yards of thread.
2. Tie ends together to make circle.
3. Put ring through circle at knot end and fasten to something.
4. Put pencil into circle and twist.
5. Twist pencil to twist yarn.
6. When tightly twisted, remove pencil and ring (holding ends firmly).
7. Bring ends of twisted yarn together.
8. Tie ends with overhand knot to keep cord from untwisting.
9. Allow yarn to twist forming a thicker cord of yarn.
10. Run hand along length of cord to make the twist even.

Run cord through all loops around netting. Tie to fit head.
